

Drug and Alcohol Recovery LASARS

In April 2011 the Department of Health announced that Oxfordshire DAAT were successful in our proposal to become a pilot area for 'Drug Recovery Payment by Results'.

Over the next six months Oxfordshire will be designing a community-based recovery system and will be going to the market for a range of providers to deliver this ground-breaking approach. Oxfordshire's PbR model and news updates are available on our website at www.oxfordshiredaat.org

The introduction of a Local Area Single Assessment and Referral Service is the first key element in the strategy. The core function of the LASAR Service is to act as a single contact point for people accessing drug and alcohol services and to reduce the number of assessments that an individual has to undertake in order to access those services.

LASARS will be a new service that will operate independently of recovery services in Oxfordshire.

The scope and scale of this service is detailed in a Memorandum of Information (MOI) which can be accessed by all interested organisations via the Procurement website referred to below. Oxfordshire DAAT is seeking to procure one provider to deliver this service.

Timings:

The DAAT would like to be in a position to appoint a provider by October 2011 and implement the new service from January 2012.
